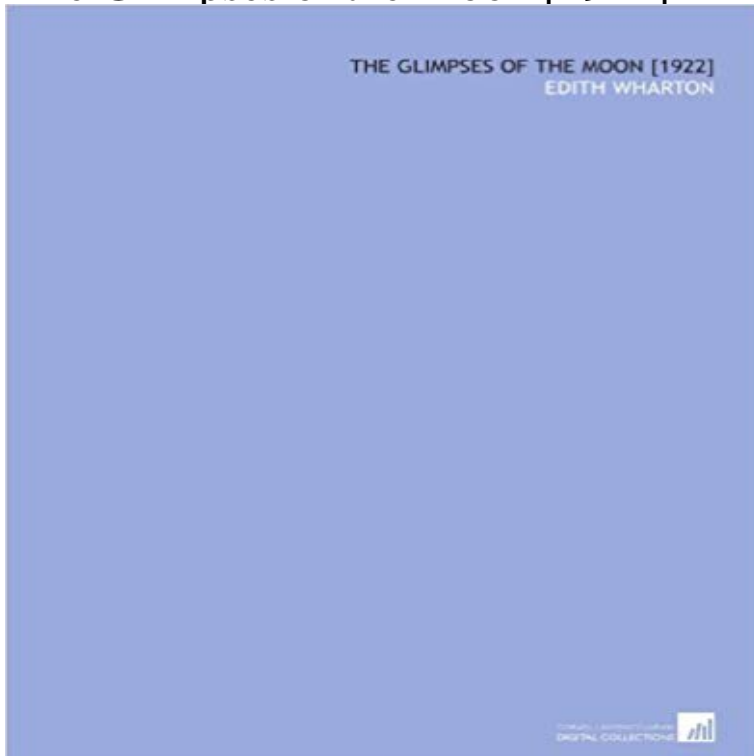


The Glimpses of the Moon [1922]
