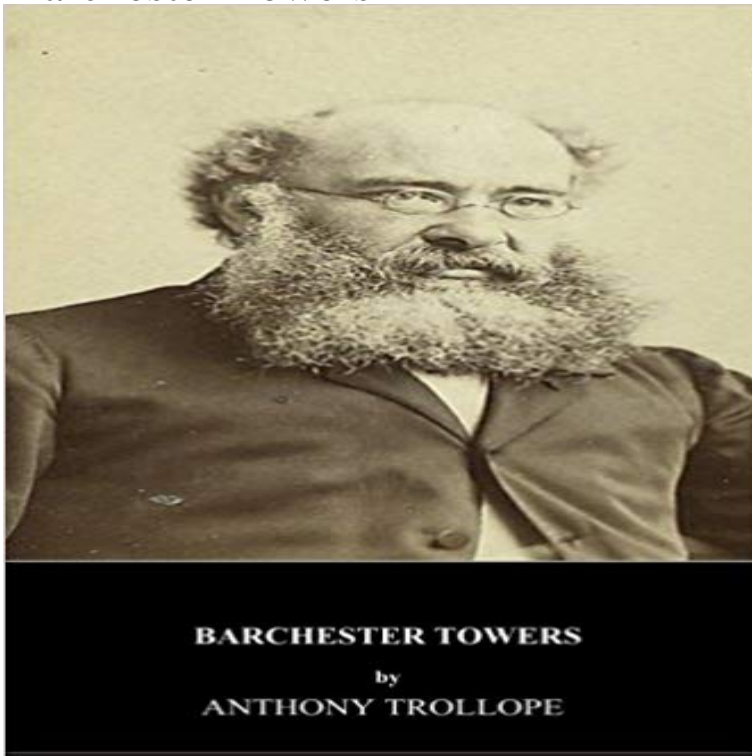


Barchester Towers
