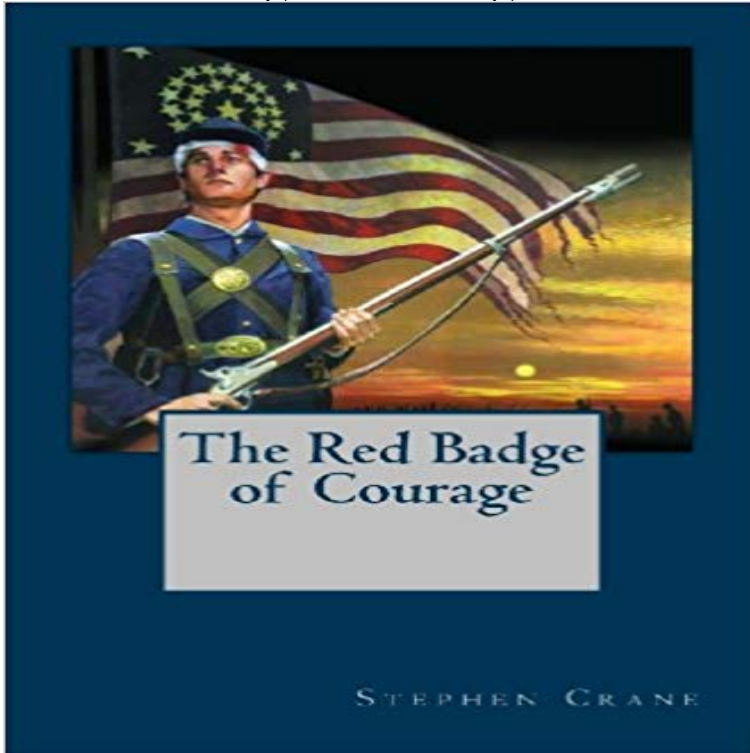


# The Red Badge of Courage



The Red Badge of Courage is a war novel by American author Stephen Crane. The novel is known for its distinctive style, which includes realistic battle sequences as well as the repeated use of color imagery, and ironic tone. Separating itself from a traditional war narrative, Cranes story reflects the inner experience of its protagonista soldier fleeing from combatrather than the external world around him. Also notable for its use of what Crane called a psychological portrayal of fear, the novels allegorical and symbolic qualities are often debated by critics. Several of the themes that the story explores are maturation, heroism, cowardice, and the indifference of nature.
